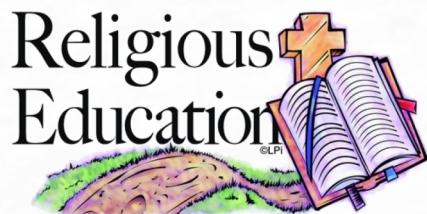

Our Religious Education Office welcomed our catechists back with a small gathering at the end of August. We served them an appreciation dinner for their ministry with our children.

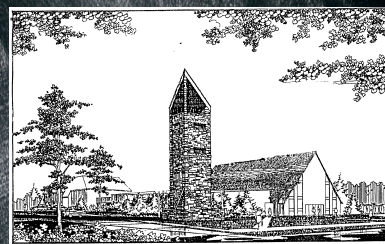

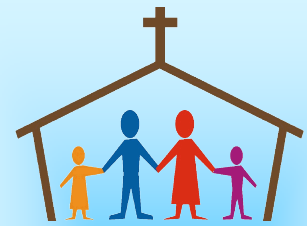

DID YOU KNOW?

You can reduce your taxes with an IRA gift. The IRA charitable rollover permits individuals who are 70 1/2 to roll over up to \$100,000 from their IRA to Sacred Heart Church and/or Sacred Heart School free from federal income tax.
